

[Expert Picks] Belgium vs Tunisia Predictions, Odds & Best Betting Tips 2026!

Belgium hosts Tunisia on June 6, 2026, in an International Friendly that carries real weight for both sides heading into the summer. Kick-off is set for 13:00, and while there is no league table at stake, the match gives both managers a genuine final opportunity to fine-tune tactics, test squad depth, and build momentum before competitive action resumes. Belgium arrive on the back of a sharp 2-0 win over Croatia on June 2 and a confidence-boosting 5-2 demolition of the USA in March, while Tunisia come in off a narrow 1-0 defeat to Austria on June 1 - form that paints a clear picture of two sides heading in very different directions right now.



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Belgium vs Tunisia Betting Preview - June 6, 2026

If you are looking for value ahead of this International Friendly, the numbers tell a compelling story. Belgium have scored 16 goals across their last five competitive matches, a run that includes a 7-0 thrashing of Liechtenstein in World Cup qualifying and three wins alongside two draws without a single defeat. Tunisia, by contrast, have posted a 1-2-2 record over the same window - one win, two draws, and two losses - scoring just 4 and conceding 5. The gap in current form is significant, and the betting markets are reflecting exactly that.

Belgium's Attacking Form Is the Key Angle

Belgium's attack is firing on all cylinders right now. The Red Devils have shown they can score against high-quality opponents as well as weaker ones, which removes the usual concern about a

strong side going flat against a modest opponent in a low-stakes friendly. Their 5-2 win over the USA and 2-0 result against Croatia are not flukes - they reflect a team with multiple goal threats, fluid movement in the final third, and the confidence that comes from consistently putting the ball in the net. Backing Belgium to score two or more goals in this fixture looks like one of the cleaner bets on the card.

Tunisia's Vulnerabilities in the Final Third

Tunisia are not without quality, but the stats from their recent run are hard to ignore from a betting standpoint. Their 1-0 defeat to Austria on June 1 came against a side that, while solid, is not in the same category as Belgium. The Round of 16 exit at the Africa Cup of Nations - a 3-2 loss to Mali - showed that Tunisia can be opened up by teams with pace and movement. They have conceded 5 goals in their last five competitive outings, and while they can grind out results against limited opposition (see: 1-0 win over Haiti, 0-0 draw with Canada), Belgium's forward line is a different proposition entirely.

Key Betting Markets to Watch

Belgium to Win - This is the headline market and the most straightforward angle. With Belgium's form, home advantage, and the quality differential between the squads, they are rightly installed as heavy favourites. The odds will be short, but the confidence here is high.

Both Teams to Score - Tunisia have shown they can find the net, having scored in competitive matches including their AFCON campaign. However, their recent friendly record features a 0-0 draw and a 1-0 defeat, suggesting they may struggle to breach a focused Belgian defence. **Both Teams to Score - No** carries some appeal, though there is always a risk Tunisia find a consolation late on.

Asian Handicap - Belgium -1.5 - Given Belgium's average of more than three goals per game across recent fixtures, backing them on the Asian Handicap at -1.5 goals offers a way to find better value than the straight win market. Tunisia are vulnerable to fast, direct attacking play and Belgium have the personnel to exploit that.

Over 2.5 Goals - With Belgium's scoring rate as high as it is, the Over 2.5 Goals line is well worth considering. Their last five competitive results include scores of 7-0, 5-2, and 2-0, making this a strong statistical lean.

Belgium to Win and Over 2.5 Goals Combined - This is arguably the sharpest value play in the match. It combines the most likely outcome with a goal line that Belgium have cleared comfortably in four of their last five competitive matches.

Team News and Tactical Notes

Belgium are expected to use this fixture to rotate their squad and give fringe players meaningful minutes, but the depth available to the Red Devils is such that even a rotated lineup will carry serious attacking threat. Tunisia's manager is also likely to experiment, but with the team coming off back-to-back matches in March and a June 1 defeat to Austria, there may be some fatigue in the legs of key players. That could be a factor in the closing stages if Belgium push the tempo.

Expert Picks Summary

Best Bet: Belgium to Win

Value Pick: Over 2.5 Goals in the Match

Each-Way Angle: Belgium -1.5 Asian Handicap

Avoid: Tunisia to Win outright - this market offers poor value relative to the risk given Tunisia's recent form and the quality of Belgium's attack.

Final Verdict

Belgium vs Tunisia on June 6, 2026, is a fixture where the form lines, squad quality, and historical head-to-head trends all point in the same direction. Belgium are in red-hot scoring form, Tunisia have shown they can be opened up by quality opposition, and the friendly setting may actually encourage Belgium to play with freedom rather than caution. Lock in Belgium to win with over 2.5 goals in the match as your headline bet, and consider the -1.5 Asian Handicap as a way to boost the return if you want to take on a little more risk for better odds.
