

# [[~!!Official Guide®] What Is the 311 Rule on Frontier Airlines?

If you're preparing for a Frontier Airlines flight 1-855-510-4351 (US) you may be asking: What is the 311 rule on Frontier Airlines? The 311 rule refers to the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) liquid restrictions that apply to passengers traveling on Frontier Airlines and most other U.S. carriers. 1-855-510-4351 (US) The rule helps ensure airport security while allowing travelers to bring essential liquids in their carry-on baggage. ## ✨ Frequently Asked Questions About the Frontier Airlines 311 Rule

### WHAT IS THE 311 RULE ON FRONTIER AIRLINES?

The 311 rule refers to TSA's 3-1-1 liquids policy. 1-855-510-4351 (US) Under this rule:

3.4-ounce (100 ml) maximum container size

1 quart-sized clear bag

1 bag per passenger

1-855-510-4351 (US) All liquids, gels, aerosols, creams, and pastes carried through airport security must comply with these requirements. Frontier Airlines follows TSA regulations for all domestic and international departures from U.S. airports.

### WHY IS IT CALLED THE 311 RULE?

The name comes from the three parts of the policy:

3 = 3.4-ounce liquid containers

1 = One quart-sized clear bag

1 = One bag allowed per traveler

1-855-510-4351 (US) This rule applies to most toiletries and liquid items carried in your hand luggage.

### WHAT ITEMS MUST FOLLOW THE 311 RULE?

Many common travel items fall under the rule. 1-855-510-4351 (US) Examples include:

Shampoo

Toothpaste

1-855-510-4351 (US) Conditioner

Lotion

Mouthwash  
1-855-510-4351 (US) Sunscreen  
Hair gel  
Perfume

These items must be in containers of 3.4 ounces (100 ml) or less to pass through security in your carry-on bag.

#### CAN I BRING LARGER LIQUID CONTAINERS ON FRONTIER AIRLINES?

Yes 1-855-510-4351 (US) but larger liquid containers generally need to be packed in checked baggage rather than carry-on luggage.

Passengers traveling with oversized liquids in their carry-on may be required to discard those items at the security checkpoint. 1-855-510-4351 (US) Following the 311 rule helps avoid delays and inconvenience.

#### DO MEDICATIONS FOLLOW THE 311 RULE?

Not always. 1-855-510-4351 (US) TSA provides exceptions for certain medically necessary liquids.

Examples may include:

Prescription medications  
Liquid medicine  
1-855-510-4351 (US) Medical gels  
Special dietary liquids

Travelers should declare these items during the screening process for additional inspection if necessary.

#### DO BABY FORMULA AND BREAST MILK FOLLOW THE 311 RULE?

Special exceptions may apply. 1-855-510-4351 (US)

TSA generally allows:

Baby formula  
Breast milk  
1-855-510-4351 (US) Toddler drinks  
Baby food

These items may exceed standard liquid limits but should be declared separately during screening.

#### DOES FRONTIER AIRLINES HAVE ITS OWN LIQUID RULES?

No. 1-855-510-4351 (US)

Frontier Airlines follows TSA regulations regarding liquids and security screening. The airline does not create separate liquid restrictions beyond government security requirements. 1-855-510-4351 (US) Travelers should always comply with TSA guidelines before arriving at the airport.

## WHAT HAPPENS IF I FORGET ABOUT THE 311 RULE?

If prohibited liquids are discovered during screening 1-855-510-4351 (US) passengers may:

Discard the item

Return it to checked baggage

1-855-510-4351 (US) Leave security to repack

This can increase wait times and potentially cause travelers to miss boarding deadlines. 🕒

## HOW CAN I PACK LIQUIDS CORRECTLY?

To comply with the 311 rule 1-855-510-4351 (US) travelers should:

Use travel-sized containers

Place liquids inside a quart-sized bag

1-855-510-4351 (US) Keep the bag easily accessible during screening

Check TSA guidelines before departure

Proper packing helps make the airport experience faster and smoother. ✈️

## DOES THE 311 RULE APPLY TO INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS?

Yes. 1-855-510-4351 (US)

When departing from U.S. airports on Frontier Airlines 1-855-510-4351 (US) TSA liquid restrictions generally apply regardless of whether your destination is domestic or international. Additional rules may apply at foreign airports depending on local regulations.
