India's Batting Collapse

India's reply was dismal against South Africa's disciplined and varied bowling attack. The top order failed to get going, and the middle order could not build any meaningful partnership. South Africa's bowlers used the Ahmedabad pitch smartly, mixing up pace and spin to keep India under constant pressure. The 76-run defeat was one of India's more heavy losses in recent T20 World Cup history, raising questions about their batting depth and ability to handle pressure situations on home soil.

South Africa's commanding win boosts their net run rate and places them in a strong position to advance to the semi-finals of the ICC Men's T20 World Cup 2025/26.
